

# Winter Ordinance Reminders

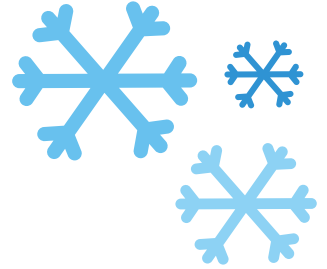

## SNOW SHOVELING

*Section 58-102*

The ordinance states that it is the responsibility of the property owner and/or occupant to shovel the sidewalk abutting the property within 24 hours of a snowfall if the snow has accumulated two or more inches in height. The purpose of this ordinance is to create safe walking spaces for pedestrians and reduce the risk of injury.



## ODD-EVEN PARKING

*Section 70-5 (D)*

From November 15 through April 1 of each year, odd-even parking regulations are in effect. In short, if the calendar date is odd you need to be parked on the odd addressed side of the road. If it is 2:00 a.m. on November 21st, your vehicle needs to be parked on the odd side of the road. However, because the rule is in effect from 2:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. you need to make sure you are parked accordingly the night before for the next day.



## SNOW PLOWING

*Section 58-17*

All snow must remain on the property of the driveway it was cleared from, or if snow is pushed into the road during plowing, it must be pushed back onto the property before the contractor leaves the site. Snow removal contractors are also not allowed to push snow into the road and leave it there or push snow into the road and then drive away raising the blade leaving the snow on the street.
